Dear Parents and Carers,

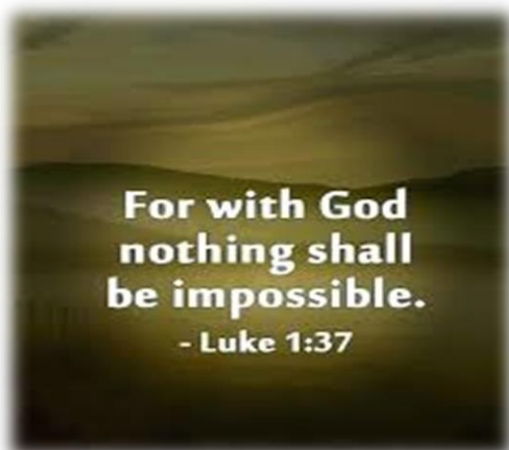

I have had contact from a resident who has expressed his concern for the children's safety and neighbours access during pick up and drop off times.
