Breakfast and After School Club are becoming increasingly fully booked (despite having increased numbers since the summer term). For safeguarding reasons, if your child is not on the register we are unable to accept them once a session is booked to capacity. Unfortunately, we have had to turn children away at the door and parents have had to make alternative arrangements. Please book in advance to avoid disappointment.



Speed

There is a speed limit of 5 mph on the school grounds. Please make sure you are driving within the speed limit as there are often children on site, both before and after school attending clubs/the swimming pool. With this in mind, you will notice new speed bumps being installed.



Parking

When dropping children off in the morning, please make sure they have been handed over to a member of Double Decker Club staff safely.
